Saugeen Student Start Up Program

About the Program



In 2019, the Saugeen Connects Partnership consisting of Brockton, Hanover, Minto, Wellington North and West Grey, along with the Saugeen Economic Development Coorporation (SEDC), will launch the Saugeen Student Start Up Program (SUPP). The Saugeen SUPP will provide the opportunity for students in this region in Grades 6-12 to try self-employment during their summer holidays, July and August. This will act as a viable way of employment and does not interfere with the students' studies throughout the school year.

This program was launched in Norfolk County in 2016 and has received multiple awards at both Provincial and National levels . It was also a finalist in the prestigious Lieutenant Governor's Award for best achievement in the province. We are so grateful that Norfolk County and the person who created the program, Jerry Sucharyna, have allowed us the opportunity to replicate SSUP here in the Saugeen Region.

The program is extremely student friendly and focused in a non-traditional way to stimulate their minds. In 2016 and 2017 in Norfolk County, 274 students applied and 137 were funded. Several schools in our region will be contacted and receive a presentation to assist students to understand the program requirements and the opportunity created just for them. Successful applicants will be notified prior to the end of June and awarded the \$200 to get them started.

Funding for this program will come from the Saugeen Connects partnership, the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs' (OMAFRA) Rural Economic Development (RED) Program, and businesses like you.


Throughout the summer students will be encouraged to use the support of the sponsors to enhance their business and maximize their experience. Half way through the summer a meet and greet will be held to provide interaction between sponsors and students to interact and be mutually encouraged. This will also provide the opportunity to highlight the value of the students to submit a summer-end report that would earn them a \$100 bonus. We will be checking in to provide tools, resources and extra promotion to participating youth.

This program will provide real experience in actual business and expose youth to the ability to offset part time work in the Saugeen Region.
